CHÂTEAU LAFITE ROTHSCHILD

Château Lafite Rothschild boasts a rich and storied history, with the first recorded mention dating to 1234. The name ‘Lafite’ derives from the old Gascon word ‘fite,’ meaning ‘mound’ or ‘hillock,’ a reference to the elevated plateau on which the vineyard sits at one of the highest points in the appellation. Among Bordeaux’s five First Growths, Lafite is perhaps the most revered for its elegance, consistency, and remarkable longevity, traits that have earned it a reputation for excellence as well as consistently high prices. The estate enjoys an exceptional terroir near the Gironde estuary, in the northern part of Pauillac, close to the border with Saint-Estèphe. Pauillac itself is home to two of the other First Growths as well: Château Latour and Château Mouton Rothschild. In terms of red Bordeaux, the wines of Pauillac are classic versions characterised with intense blackcurrant flavours and aromas that develop into pencil lead, cedar and cigar box with age. The wines have a vibrant acidity and a firm tannic structure which enables the wines to age gracefully over many decades in the successful vintages. Amongst these Pauillac wines, Lafite has always held a particular allure. It is undoubtedly one of the world’s greatest wines. For power there are other châteaux, but for elegance and finesse, there is Lafite.

CHÂTEAU LATOUR

Located in the commune of Pauillac — home to three of Bordeaux’s five First Growths — Château Latour is renowned for the remarkable longevity and unwavering quality of the wines that have been produced here for centuries. Although Latour makes legendary wines in the best vintages, it is this estate’s consistent ability to turn out exceptional wines in vintages that are deemed to have been off-years that marks it out from its peers. This is thanks to the vineyard’s extraordinary terroir and climate, with the proximity of the vines to the nearby estuary meaning that they benefit from its temperature-moderating effects, which in extremely cold (1991) and extremely hot (2003) years has proved to be a lifeline for the vines. Some of the finest vintages of the 20th and 21st centuries produced at Latour include 1949, 1961, 1982, 1990, 2009 and 2010.

CHÂTEAU MARGAUX

The wines of Château Margaux are celebrated for their elegance and multilayered complexity, with violet floral and acacia aromatics and intense, spiced cassis fruit flavours.

The majority of the vineyards are on deep gravel and gravely clay-limestone soils that are ideally suited to Cabernet Sauvignon. Merlot is planted on soils which have higher content of clay and limestone. the diversity of soils contributes to the complexity and depth of their wines.

There have been many moments of startling brilliance, such as the exceptional, legendary 1784 vintage that wooed Thomas Jefferson, along with stunning wines produced in 1893, 1900, 1929, 1945, 1949, 1953, 1955, 1959 and 1961.

Since the Mentzelopoulos family took over in 1977, the wines have been on particularly outstanding form; the top vintages from the 1980s, 1990s, 2000s and onwards are nothing short of spectacular. Superlative wines were produced in the following vintages: 1982, 1983, 1986, 1990, 1996, 2000, 2005, 2009, 2010, 2015, 2016, 2018 and 2019.

Of the vintages that appear regularly at Christie's auctions, the most highly sought-after are the monumental 1900, 1945, 1947, 1953, 1982, 1990, 1996, 2005, 2009 and 2010 vintages.

CHÂTEAU MOUTON ROTHSCHILD

In 1853, Baron Nathaniel de Rothschild purchased Château Brane-Mouton and renamed it Château Mouton Rothschild. In 1924, Baron Philippe de Rothschild broke with Bordeaux tradition by bottling his entire harvest at the Château and commissioned poster artist Jean Carlu to design the label — an avant-garde gesture that anticipated Mouton’s later fusion of art and wine. Two decades later, in 1945, to commemorate the Année de la Victoire, Baron Philippe again turned to an artist, Philippe Jullian, whose label design began the tradition of commissioning a different artist for each vintage — a practice that continues today (with the exceptions of 1953 and 1977). Over the years, such luminaries as Picasso, Kandinsky, Dalí, Francis Bacon, and Andy Warhol have contributed to the series, further elevating the estate’s cultural stature. Château Mouton Rothschild was elevated to First Growth status in 1973. The estate encompasses 82 hectares of vineyards, 77 of which are planted to red varieties: 77% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Merlot, 9% Cabernet Franc, and 2% Petit Verdot. The vines that inform the Grand Vin average 48 years of age and are planted at a density of 8,500 per hectare on deep gravel soils characteristic of Pauillac.

CHÂTEAU HAUT-BRION

Château Haut-Brion has been celebrated for centuries, its renown dating at least to a 1663 review in the diary of Samuel Pepys. In 1935, the estate was purchased by American financier Clarence Dillon, whose family continues to steward it today through his granddaughter, Joan Dillon, President of Domaine Clarence Dillon, and her son, His Royal Highness Prince Robert of Luxembourg, who serves as Vice President and Managing Director. In 1983, the family expanded their holdings with the acquisition of neighboring Château La Mission Haut-Brion.

The average age of Haut-Brion’s vines exceeds 35 years, with some parcels dating back to the 1930s. Red grapes are hand-sorted in the vineyard before being destemmed, lightly crushed to release the juice, and transferred to fermentation vats. Indigenous yeasts conduct the alcoholic fermentation under carefully controlled temperatures, followed by a maceration period of roughly 15 days. Malolactic fermentation occurs naturally through native lactic bacteria. After blending, the wine is aged for 18 to 24 months in predominantly new oak barrels crafted in Haut-Brion’s own cooperage, allowing complete control over the barrels’ (typically medium-minus) toasting.

Distinct among the First Growths, Château Haut-Brion is prized for its unmistakable Graves character — earthy, smoky, and mineral — married to an opulent texture and extraordinary ageworthiness.

CHÂTEAU LA MISSION HAUT-BRION

Considered by some as the unofficial sixth growth from the Left Bank of Bordeaux, Château La Mission Haut-Brion has an enviable reputation for producing complex, age-worthy and intensely flavoured reds and vibrant whites from their sublime terroir in the Pessac-Léognan appellation, located just a few miles from the city centre of Bordeaux.

In 1983, Château La Mission Haut-Brion was acquired by Domaine Clarence Dillon, also the owners of Château Haut-Brion, reuniting these two sister properties. The vineyards of La Mission Haut-Brion are located just across the road from Haut-Brion; however, there are significant differences between the two properties. Although some vines are planted in Pessac, most of the vineyards at La Mission are in the Bordeaux suburb of Talence, which is slightly flatter but still has excellent drainage and exposition. The soil is slightly richer, with a gravel soil over a subsoil of clay, sand and limestone. In comparison, the vineyards of Haut-Brion are located in Pessac with a slightly lower density of planting.

There is no disputing the extremely high quality of the wines produced by both of these world-renowned Estates. In certain vintages, La Mission Haut-Brion rivals – and occasionally surpasses – its illustrious neighbor, as exemplified by the exceptional 1982 vintage.

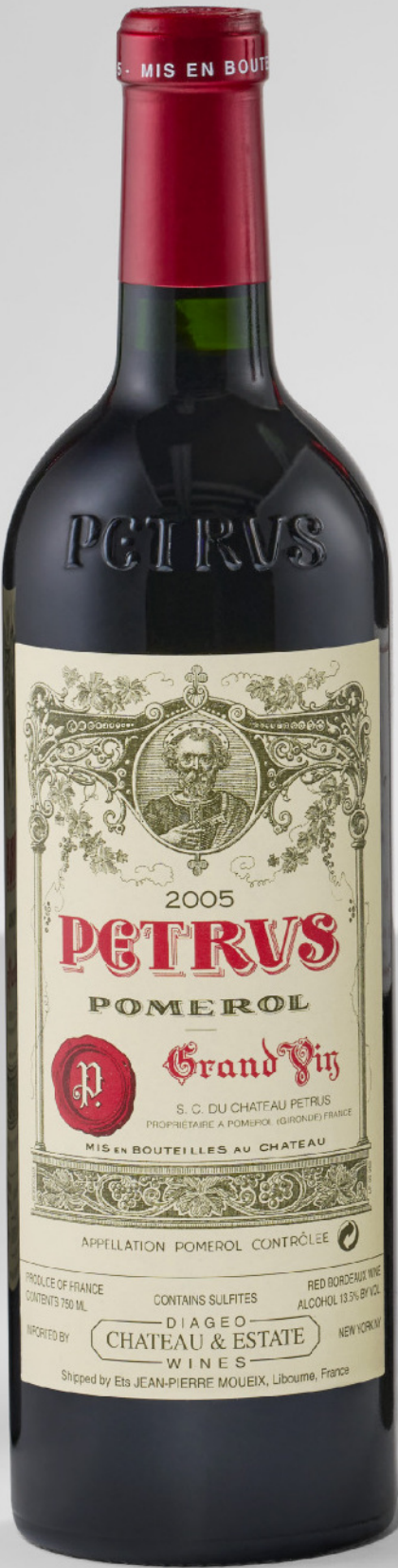
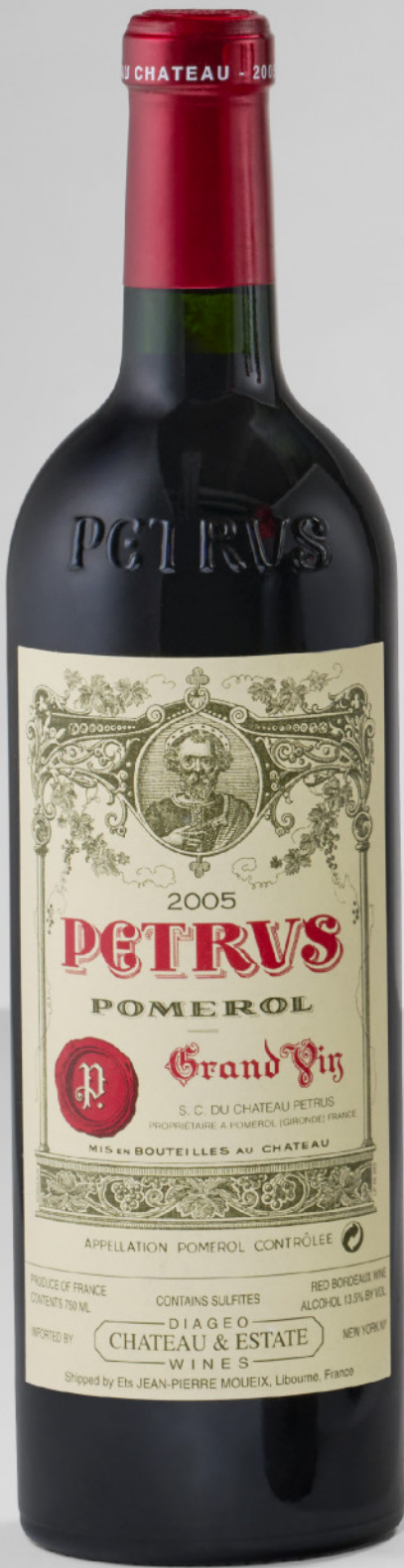

CHÂTEAU LAFLEUR

The vineyard of Lafleur is an otherwise contiguous parcel bisected by the crossing of two country roads. Just 600 feet north of Petrus, it shares vineyard rows with La Fleur-Petrus in one direction and Lafleur-Gazin in another. The soils are predominantly gravelly yet contain a higher proportion of clay than neighboring estates — an element that underpins the wine’s remarkable depth, power, and longevity, much as it does at Petrus.

Covering barely ten acres, the vineyard is planted in equal parts Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Only Vieux Château Certan rivals Lafleur in its devotion to Cabernet Franc (by contrast, Petrus contains just 5% of the variety, and it is seldom used in the final blend). The vines average more than thirty years of age and are densely planted at approximately 5,900 vines per hectare.

Lafleur’s greatness can be found in the tension between its two cépages: Merlot lending sensual richness and Cabernet Franc imparting aromatic lift, structure, and precision — together producing wines of haunting perfume and extraordinary longevity, unmatched even among Pomerol’s elite.
